since its founding, the association has played a pivotal rule in shaping education policy through legislative advocacy, professional development and strategic partnerships with Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES, the New York State School Boards Association (NYSSBA) and the National School Boards Association and

the association has led significant initiatives, including the formation of key committees in 1976, the introduction of seminars for prospective school board members in 1977 and the publication of its first legislative position paper in 1978, advocating for fair state aid, local control over union membership and refuef from infranded mandates, and Whereas,
